While we cannot provide 100% funding for every member from countries where AAC is in an emerging state, we will evaluate all submissions and hopefully provide some assistance to a number of people.

If your application is successful but you find you are not able to attend the conference, please let Franklin know by **28**th **February 2018** so the money can be reallocated.

The conference will provide opportunities to meet, network, and share ideas with other people from Emerging AAC Nations. Many of the conference presentations will focus specifically on developing and enhancing strategies to further develop AAC in Emerging Nations.

We invite members from emerging countries who feel they will actively work towards the ongoing development of AAC in their countries to apply.
