A maximum of four grants (CDN \$500 to each successful applicant) will be awarded to offset the costs of attending the conference. The closing date for applications is 22:00 GMT on March 14, 2014. All applicants will be advised of the selection committee's decision by March 28, 2014.

ISAAC Awards & Scholarships are presented every two years in conjunction with the Biennial Conference. Only current ISAAC members are eligible to apply.
