Instructions for Earning ASHA CEUs

- Scan your badge into each session attended. ONLY complete the <u>Continuing Education Activity</u> <u>Attendance Form</u> to record attendance at Poster Sessions. Titles do not appear on CE transcripts. Employers, school districts, licensing agencies, or specialty recognition boards may ask you for the titles of the sessions that you attend.
 - Write the date, number and the title of each Poster Session attended.
 - Record the length of the Poster Session in minutes.
- Complete the <u>CEU Participant Form</u>, a fillable PDF, using your ASHA account number (no Social Security numbers will be accepted). <u>Email the completed CEU Participant Form to</u> <u>POurand@aslsinc.com</u>
- 3. Complete the <u>ISAAC Conference Evaluation</u> prior to returning the documentation at the end of the conference.
