



ISAAC CONFERENCE 2016 CALL FOR PAPERS Theme: Bringing Us Together / Ce qui nous rassemble Submission Guidelines

Proposals will be selected based on relevance, scientific quality, content area, importance, and program balance. Only unpublished abstracts may be submitted, and those deemed to be submitted solely for marketing purposes will not be accepted.

All program presenters are expected to follow ethical procedures to protect the privacy and confidentiality of people mentioned in their presentations. Images and likenesses, including audio recordings and photographs or video data, must only be used with the permission of the person depicted. Real names or initials must only be used with participant's permission; otherwise pseudonyms stated as not being the person's real name must be used.

ISAAC will own the copyright on all proposals accepted for the conference, which must include both a "Short" and "Long", or "Extended", abstract. The short abstracts must be entered into the paper submission portal as plain text, and will be published in the Conference Final Program, while the extended abstracts will be entered as a PDF file upload and published in the Conference Proceedings. Both will be provided to all Main Conference registrants during the event. Authors accepted to the program are expected to register their attendance for the event. Conference registration pricing rates will be released publicly in advance of acceptance notifications being sent.

If you do not have access to the full version, then the ASHA forms can always be scanned as picture files, and embedded within the Word version of the Long or Extended Abstract, prior to creating the final PDF version.

NOTE: Do not include any identifying information in the extended abstract. Papers containing identifying information will be returned to the author(s) as non-reviewable. Author(s) solely responsible for removing identifying information and re-submitting returned papers.

- Describe models of AAC service delivery in use throughout the nation/world.
- Discuss successful strategies to develop/sustain literacy learning by individuals who use AAC.
- Discuss the connections between cultural and social issues and AAC.
- Discuss issues regarding vocabulary development, language acquisition, and/or literacy as they relate to AAC.

AUTHORS MUST INCLUDE ONE OF THESE STATEMENTS IN THEIR LONG ABSTRACT:

Declaration of Interest Statement

- 1. The authors disclose they have no financial or other interest in objects or entities mentioned in this paper.
- 2. The authors disclose they have the following financial or other interests in objects or entities mentioned in this paper (provide specific details).

Required Inclusions for the Short Abstract:

- Maximum 250 words, no references, plain text (can be copied from a Word document and pasted into online submission form)
- Research paper: Aim, Method, Results, Conclusion
- Anecdote / personal experience or reflection paper: Content and focus of presentation
- Product or industry / commercial paper: Main focus and purpose of paper

Requirements for the Long or Extended Abstract:

- Extended Abstract submitted in PDF format only as electronic upload
- Maximum 1,000 words, maximum of 10 references
- Formatting must be Arial 12 point font, single spaced
- Must have Declaration of Interest statement
- Must provide a more detailed description of the session contents for the conference proceedings
- Research paper: Aim, Method, Results, Conclusion, Declaration of Interest
- Anecdote / personal experience or reflection paper: Content and focus of presentation, Declaration of Interest
- Product paper: Must disclose interests, cannot be only promotional as these are more appropriately displayed and delivered in the Exhibit Hall

- 1. Applicants will be notified of acceptance by February 19th, 2016.
- The Program Committee will make final decisions on allocating all accepted papers to streams and content focus
 areas as well as the final format of the presentations (i.e., poster and length of presentations). Format and
 schedule of accepted papers will be communicated to successful presenters by April 18th, 2016.
- **3.** This Call for Papers does **not** include a call for pre-conference workshops. Presenters for pre-conference workshops are by invitation only.
