

## How to Participate in the Conference 2016 Town Hall

The **Town Hall Meeting** will take place on Monday, August 8th from **3:00 to 5:00 pm, in the Metro Ballroom West.**

The topic is **"What Brings us Together?"**

The following 6 key questions will be used to guide discussion. The moderators will introduce each question one at a time, and give everyone the opportunity to share their thoughts.

**\*\*It is recommended you program your ideas ahead of time as stored messages for quick retrieval.**

Everyone gets a turn during Town Hall. Volunteers will bring a microphone to you when it is your turn to talk.

### Questions to help you prepare:

- 1. Introduce yourself and tell us about your culture and where you are from?**
  - a. How are we the same?**
  - b. How are we different?**
- 2. What makes ME strong?**
- 3. What makes us strong together?**
- 4. How can we change the world?**
- 5. If you could do anything you wanted to, what would it be?**

### Tips:

- Consider ahead of time what you want to say during Town Hall.
- Get some things ready to say before you come or while you are waiting.
- Prepare to tell everyone your name.
- Make sure you are wearing your name tag.
- It is a good idea to have a note about how you communicate.
- Take note of where the people with the mics are in the room.
- Get the attention of a person with a mic when you are ready to talk.
- Tell the person with the mic how you communicate or show them your note.
- The person with the mic will tell you when it is your turn.
- If you have a device, show the person with the mic where the speaker is and turn up the volume when it is your turn to talk.
- If you need help, ask a volunteer.
