RE: Travel Award for Emerging Researchers' Attendance at the ISAAC 2014 Biennial Conference

Once again, we are pleased to advise that ISAAC has funding available for providing emerging researchers with financial support to attend the <u> 16^{th} Biennial Conference of ISAAC</u></u>, to be held in Lisbon, Portugal, July 19 - 24, 2014.

ISAAC recognizes the need to promote research in augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) throughout the world and to provide incentives to those involved in innovative AAC research. Providing financial support that allows early career researchers to attend ISAAC Conferences is an important aspect of ISAAC's ongoing work in the field of AAC. The successful candidates will be expected to attend and present their research at the main conference, and to attend the Research Symposium (following the main conference).

While ISAAC will not be able to provide 100% funding for every qualified applicant, we will evaluate all submissions and provide what would be meaningful financial assistance to as many suitable applicants as we can. Please note applications can only be accepted from ISAAC members in good standing who meet a range of criteria for this competitive award. The applications are judged on their merits by the Research Committee of ISAAC.

Please complete and submit the attached application and supporting documents by email to <u>bronwyn.hemsley@newcastle.edu.au</u> by 5:00 p.m. on 1^{st} November, 2013 AEST (Australian Eastern Standard Time). Applicants must also submit a separate conference paper proposal on the research that forms the basis of their application for the travel award, through the Main Conference paper submission portal (<u>https://www.isaac-online.org/english/conference-2014/call-for-papers/</u>) by 15^{th} October, 2013. Successful applicants will be advised of the outcome of their application by 1^{st} December, 2013.

We look to receiving your application, and to meet and network with a promising group of emerging researchers in AAC at ISAAC 2014. Please note that our biennial Research Symposium will be held on July 25-26, immediately following the conference.
