ISAAC and AssistiveWare[®] are pleased to announce that funding is once again available for the ISAAC travel assistance grant program designed to support new or recent graduates who are working in a professional capacity in the field of AAC to attend and participate in the ISAAC Biennial Conference. <u>ISAAC Conference 2016</u> will be held in Toronto, Canada, August 6–13, 2016. "New professionals" are defined as recent graduates, i.e., five years or less since graduation, from a recognized academic program related to the field of AAC, e.g., Speech-Language Pathology, Special Education, or Occupational Therapy (or equivalent in applicant's country). A maximum of four grants (CDN \$500 to each successful applicant) will be awarded to offset the costs of attending the conference. The closing date for applications is 22:00 GMT on March 14, 2016. All applicants will be advised of the selection committee's decision by March 31, 2016.

ISAAC Awards & Scholarships are presented every two years in conjunction with the Biennial Conference. Only current ISAAC members are eligible to apply.
