






Location Information

Public transport

Catch the fully accessible G:link (light rail tram network) to **Gold Coast University Hospital station**. Take the elevator or lift up to the road level and look for an ISAAC 2018 volunteer in a bright green t-shirt. The ISAAC 2018 volunteers will guide you through the university campus to the G17 building.

If traveling from Brisbane via train you will need to change to the G:link at Helensvale station.








<u>By car</u>

Free parking is available in Carparks **E**, **D**, and **G**. A different parking code is required for each day (see details on the next page).







Saturday 21st July - CODE INSTRUCTIONS FOR EVENT PARKING:

Please enter the following details into the parking machines to receive free parking.

- Enter your license plate number then Press OK
- Press OK again (this selects the 'Permit' option shown on screen not the right/left arrows CC / Cash)
- Enter in 61512 as your permit number
- Press OK
- It will search for a permit, and then say that there is \$6 parking, valid until the end of the day
- Choose Y/N for your receipt

Sunday 22nd July - CODE INSTRUCTIONS FOR EVENT PARKING:

Please enter the following details into the parking machines to receive free parking.

- Enter your license plate number then Press OK
- Press OK again (this selects the 'Permit' option shown on screen not the right/left arrows CC / Cash)
- Enter in 84674 as your permit number
- Press OK
- It will search for a permit, and then say that there is \$6 parking, valid until the end of the day
- Choose Y/N for your receipt
